A. Here at CBC we value <u>Loving</u> God, <u>Loving</u> Others, and <u>Reaching</u> Out.

But when the Pharisees heard that he had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together. And one of them, a lawyer, asked him a question to test him. "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?" And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. - C. The 2020Vision is so much bigger than Luthercare for Kids or any other ministry at CBC; it is the <u>90,000</u> people in our local community.
 - 1. To reach this local community and beyond, each of us must <u>GO</u>.

Biblical mandate to go:

GO therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.

2. How do we go?

As we go, we will pray.

As we go, we will walk alongside people and point them to <u>Jesus</u>.
