- Missionary and coworker to Paul
- Physician
- · Greek, Gentile

Who was Theophilus, the recipient?

- Name means "one who loves God"
- Person of position and/or wealth
- Gentile

When was it written?

• Likely between 59-63 A.D.

Why was it written?

 Provide a "certainty" about the life and deeds of Jesus as a <u>historical</u> account.

Key Verse: Luke 19:10

"The Son of Man came to seek and save the lost."

The third chapter of The Gospel According to Luke

Be like John...

- 1. Be faithful to guard the gospel. (Luke 3:18; 1 Timothy 6:20-21; 2 Peter 2:1-2)
- 2. Be faithful to preach the same gospel no matter the <u>audience</u>. (Luke 3:19; Romans 1:16)
- 3. Be faithful to share the gospel no matter the <u>cost</u>. (Luke 3:20; Mark 6:14-29; Matthew 5:11)
