We can choose the identity of a <u>settler</u> or a <u>sojourner</u>.

(1 Peter 1:17, 2:11-12)

The Settler

- A settler places confidence in the things of this <u>life</u>. (Philippians 3:2-9)
- 2. A settler runs after the stuff of this <u>world</u>. (Philippians 3:18-19; 1 Peter 2:11)

The Sojourner

- 1. A sojourner has a singular focus. (Philippians 3:10-11)
- A sojourner keeps his <u>eyes</u> on his real <u>home</u>. (Philippians 3:13-14)
- 3. A sojourner waits for Jesus' return. (Philippians 3:20-21)

"I have given them your word, and the world has hated them, because they do not belong to the world, just as I do not belong to the world. I am not asking you to take them out of the world, but that you keep them safe from the evil one. They do not belong to the world just as I do not belong to the world. Set them apart in the truth; your word is truth. Just as you sent me into the world, so I sent them into the world."
