What do we know about the Antichrist? (1 John 2:18)

- 1. The Antichrist is referred to as the beast and the man of lawlessness.** (Revelation 13:1; 2 Thessalonians 2:3)

- 2. The Antichrist will be given power and authority from Satan.** (Revelation 13:2)

- 3. The Antichrist will be resurrected from the dead.** (Revelation 13:3)

- 4. The Antichrist will be worshiped.** (Revelation 13:3-4, 8; 2 Thessalonians 2:4)

- 5. The Antichrist will make war on the "saints."** (Revelation 13:7; Daniel 7:25)

6. **The Antichrist will only be able to do what God allows.**
(Revelation 13:5, 7)

7. **The Antichrist will be revealed when the Christians have been removed.** (2 Thessalonians 2:6-8)

8. **The Antichrist will use miracles, signs, and wonders to deceive.** (2 Thessalonians 2:3, 9-12)

9. **The Antichrist will be thrown into the lake of fire.**
(Revelation 19:19-20, 20:10; 2 Thessalonians 2:3)

Conclusion: God wins! (Daniel 7:26-27)

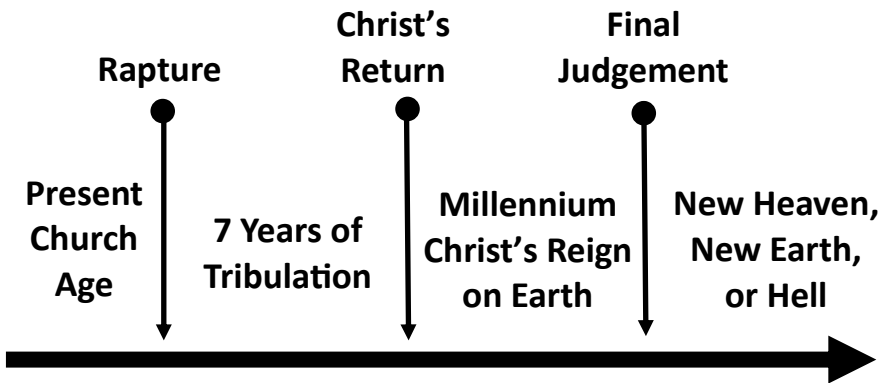
