What does it look like to "be like Stephen"?

#### The Man and His Character (Acts 6:1-10)

- Good <u>reputation</u>.
- Full of the Spirit.
- · Full of wisdom.
- Full of faith.
- Full of grace.
- Full of power.

#### The Accusations Against Him (Acts 6:11-15)

Stephen was being accused of:

- Speaking blasphemous words against Moses and the Law.
- Speaking blasphemous words against God.
- Speaking against the Temple.

#### Stephen's Response (Acts 7:1-53)

Three "Sacred Cows" Stephen responds to:

- Sacred Cow 1: The land
- Sacred Cow 2: The exaltation and glorification of the Law and Moses
- Sacred Cow 3: The Temple

The Result (Acts 7:54-60)

Stephen is stoned to death.

#### What does it look like to "be like Jesus"?

- Pursue being a person with a good <u>reputation</u>. (Proverbs 22:21; 1 Peter 2:11-12)
- 2. Pursue being a person full of the <u>Holy Spirit</u>. (Galatians 5:16-17, 22-23)
- 3. Pursue being a person full of <u>wisdom</u>. (Proverbs 13:20; Proverbs 8:10-11)
- 4. Pursue being a person full of <u>faith</u>. (Hebrews 11:1)
- 5. Pursue being a person full of grace.
- 6. Pursue being a person full of <u>power</u>. (Acts 1:8)
- 7. Know <u>God's Word</u>. (Psalm 119:105; 2 Timothy 2:15; 1 Peter 3:15)
- 8. Be prepared to <u>count the cost</u>. (2 Timothy 3:12)
