Two of God's attributes:

1. <u>Infinite</u> (1 Kings 8:27; Psalm 33:11, 41:13, 90:2; John 17:5; 2 Timothy 1:9)

Definition: The infinite nature of God simply means that God is <u>eternal</u> and exists outside of and is not limited by <u>time</u> or <u>space</u>. It simply means "<u>without limits</u>."

"The infinity of God is that perfection of God by which He is free from all limitations... He is in no way limited by the universe, by this time-space world, or confined to the universe."

 Immutable (Malachi 3:6; Numbers 23:19; 1 Samuel 15:29; James 1:17)

Definition: The immutability of God refers to His quality of not changing. The Bible is clear that God does not change His mind, His will, or His nature.
