Two of God's attributes:

1. **Infinite** (1 Kings 8:27; Psalm 33:11, 41:13, 90:2; John 17:5; 2 Timothy 1:9)

Definition: The infinite nature of God simply means that God is eternal and exists outside of and is not limited by time or space. It simply means "without limits."

"The infinity of God is that perfection of God by which He is free from all limitations... He is in no way limited by the universe, by this time-space world, or confined to the universe."

2. **Immutable** (Malachi 3:6; Numbers 23:19; 1 Samuel 15:29; James 1:17)

Definition: The immutability of God refers to His quality of not changing. The Bible is clear that God does not change His mind, His will, or His nature.

&

God is trustworthy
