When we talk about "heartbeat," we're normally referring to what motivates our behavior.

- What we <u>see</u> on the <u>outside</u> reveals what's going on in the inside.
- In Luke 19:1-10, we <u>see</u> Jesus' heartbeat, His desire to further His <u>kingdom</u> in the lives of others.

Takeaway: One of the evidences of <u>seeing</u> God is the <u>seeking</u> of others.

Obedience-based service to God:

- 1. Simple <u>obedience</u> to a simple <u>invitation</u> (Acts 16:30, 13:3-4; Genesis 12:4)
 - What do people hear/know about you that causes them to seek (or not to seek) you?
 - People are floating invitations to us-will you respond?

2. Seeking with God's heart and eyes

(Matthew 21:28-31a; Joshua 24:15; Genesis 7:5, 12:1-4; Exodus 4:3, 6, 20, 24:3-4; Acts 13:1-4)

- Jesus models intentionality.
- We have to go and seek.
- Delayed obedience is disobedience.
- <u>Selective</u> obedience is disobedience.

3. Obedient seeking at CBC

- Obedience is a <u>lifestyle</u>, not an isolated act.
- Obedience reveals your <u>heartbeat</u>.

If I don't want to obey God, I probably have to review my image of God, because Who God is to me drives my heartbeat to serve Him.

Takeaway: One of the evidences of <u>seeing</u> God is the <u>seeking</u> of others.
