When you are seeking directions for life, remember...

Jesus said, I Am...

1. The Way: We are lost without Him.

(Proverbs 14:12; Colossians 2:6-7)

“Jesus does not only give advice and directions. He takes us by the hand and leads us; he strengthens us and guides us personally every day. He does not tell us about the way; he is the way.”

(Matthew 10:39; John 10:10; John 1:3-4)

What do I think is needed to have a good life?
