2. Bow down in worship. (Romans 12:1)

Questions for reflection:

- What is getting in the way of my worship of God?
- What do I worship other than God?
- How will I worship God this week?

3. Offer God your <u>heart</u>. (Matthew 15:7-9, 22:37-38)

Questions for reflection:

- What am I hanging onto that is keeping me from offering God my heart?
- Is God knocking on the door of my heart? Am I willing to let Him in?
