# A. What is a biblical perspective on same-sex attraction?

 As a result of living in a broken and sinful world, individuals will experience <u>same-sex</u> attractions. (Genesis 3:23-24)

"If people are born with same-sex desires, it doesn't mean that same-sex love is God's design. Because of Adam and Eve's sin, we've all inherited a rebellious nature with sinful desires leading to death (Romans 7:14-18). Intrinsic desires don't determine whether a longing is good or bad. God's word alone defines truth. Sexuality is determined by our Designer, not our desires. (Psalm 19:7-11)"

- 2. Same-sex attraction is a <u>temptation</u>, not a sin. (James 1:13-15)
- 3. The Bible describes homosexual acts as <u>sinful</u>. (Romans 1:24-27)
- 4. The Bible describes homosexuality as one of many sins, not the <u>worst</u> of all sins. (Romans 1:28-31)
- 5. Through Christ, homosexuals can be cleansed, forgiven, and live <u>victoriously</u>. (1 Corinthians 6:9-11)

"Without Christ you're powerless to change, but Christ redefines and changes all who trust Him. Willpower won't overcome sin. Those who accept Christ receive a new Spirit and new identity defined by Christ's work on the cross. God may or may not remove a Christian's same-sex attraction, but the Holy Spirit will give him or her a supernatural ability to resist temptation and live joyfully in God's will."

# B. How should Christians respond?

now should christians respond:	
1.	With the grace and truth of Jesus. (John 1:14-17)
	<ul> <li>Grace means we show love and compassion. (Matthew 9:36)</li> </ul>
	• Grace means we develop relationships and friendships with them. (Luke 15:1-2)
	• Truth means we lovingly challenge believers to turn from their sin. (Matthew 18:15; Galatians 6:1)
	Truth means we challenge nonbelievers to embrace the gospel. (Romans 1:18)
2.	We treat them with dignity and <u>respect</u> . (1 Peter 2:17)
3.	We need to do all that is within our power to <u>protect</u> children from deceptive lies. (Luke 17:1-3)

# C. How should churches respond?

1. We need to have <u>grace-filled</u> environments where people are free to talk about same-sex attraction.

"God deeply loves people with same-sex attraction. Sadly, many churches have ostracized gay identified people. God doesn't see people with same-sex attraction as greater sinners than others. Every time the New Testament references homosexual practice as a sexual sin, it is within the context of other sins. He offers the same redemptive plan to *all* people. He discourages any sexual sin (regardless of gender attraction) outside of His plan for sexual expression because He loves us and sin is destructive."

- 3. We need to provide the tools and <u>resources</u> to help them live victorious lives.

- 2. Pursue holiness. (Titus 2:11-12)
- 3. Wait for the blessed hope of the return of <u>Christ</u>. (Titus 2:12-13)
