## Marks of a true follower of Jesus:

1. There is evidence of the <u>Holy Spirit</u>. (Acts 19:1-7; Ephesians 1:13-14; John 3:3-7; Titus 3:4-6)

"When a person is genuinely converted to faith in Jesus, he or she gets *new affections*. Old loves, desires, and interests are replaced with new ones. Those who have become new creations in Christ (2 Cor 5:17) experience a new love for Jesus, his church, and his mission. The converts in Ephesus illustrate this dynamic. The Ephesians loved many things—sports, theater, idols (especially their famed goddess, Artemis), and wealth. But when Paul preached the gospel and the Holy Spirit opened the eyes of many in the city, they experienced a change in affections."

2. There is a turning from <u>sin</u> and <u>sinful</u> practices. (Acts 19:17-20; Galatians 5:19-21)
