Why does the resurrection matter?

A.	It confirms the <u>deity</u> of Jesus. (Luke 22:70-23:3)
	"Jesus was either a liar, a lunatic, or Lord." -C.S. Lewis
В.	It is the basis for our confidence of <u>eternal</u> <u>life</u> with Christ. (1 Corinthians 15:21-22)
C.	It is a confirmation that Jesus is the Messiah, the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecy, who paid the

penalty for our sin. (Isaiah 53:4, 5, 10)

Conclusion:

We need to choose...

A. If the resurrection is a fraud, Christianity has no foundation and we should live for <u>ourselves</u> and this world. (1 Corinthians 15:32b)

"Without the resurrection there is no Christianity. In fact, our own Bible tells us in 1 Corinthians 15 that if the resurrection did not happen and we believe it did, then we are fools."
