A. Jesus has given us a mission to make disciples of all nations. (Matthew 28:19-20)

B. Living on mission for Christ will involve: (Acts 1:1-8)

1. The power of the Holy Spirit.

2. Being a witness wherever you are.

- "You are the salt of the earth...You are the light of the world." -Jesus, Matthew 5:13, 14
- Being a witness is who we are, not something to add to our "to-do" list.

• "For the better part of two centuries, Western evangelicalism has championed the model of proclamation and invitation by a religious professional. Typically, unbelievers have been invited to venture onto Christian turf (i.e. our church building) once or twice a year on Christmas, Easter or "Bring-a-Friend Day." They listen to a full-time, religious professional proclaim a message and are then invited to accept it...While those approaches have certainly yielded some results, I would suggest that they are increasingly ineffective and inaccessible to the majority of lost people today. There is a better way than proclaiming the truth from our world. It's living and proclaiming the truth in their world."
