“No one can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money.”

- Jesus, Matthew 6:24

A. Money will be my “master” if my social status is connected to my wealth and possessions. Therefore, I must...

1. Repent of living for the applause and approval of man.
2. Choose to live for an audience of one.
(Galatians 1:10)

B. Money will be my “master” if my happiness is connected to my possessions and experiences. Therefore, I must ...

1. Repent of worshipping God’s gifts rather than Him as the giver.
2. Look to Jesus and my relationship with Him for my joy.
(John 15:9-11)

C. Money will be my “master” if my security is found in my wealth and savings. Therefore, I must...

1. Repent of putting my hope in wealth and savings.
(1 Timothy 6:17)
2. Trust God to provide for my future needs.
(Matthew 6:25-34; Philippians 4:19; 2 Corinthians 9:8)

D. Money will be my “master” if my worth and significance are connected to my wealth and possessions. Therefore, I must...

1. Repent of looking to my wealth and possessions for my identity and significance.
2. Choose to find my worth, value, and significance from being a child of God who is blessed, loved, accepted, chosen, forgiven, adopted, and redeemed. (Ephesians 1:3-7)
