Reasons why we should live with an eternal perspective:

1. We will trade in our earthly tents for eternal <u>houses</u>. (2 Corinthians 5:1-5)

"The language of *building*, *house*, and "overclothing" indicates that our future life with the Lord will involve some form of material existence. Disembodiment is not the hope of the Christian. This means that there is some manner of continuity between our present and future forms of existence."

2. We can be of good <u>courage</u>, even when facing death. (2 Corinthians 5:6-8)

3. We will all appear before the <u>judgment</u> seat of Christ. (2 Corinthians 5:9-10)
