Three important questions related to salvation that we see in Acts 15:

1. Salvation- What does it really take?

• <u>Faith</u> alone by <u>grace</u> alone. (Acts 15:7; Ephesians 2:8-9; Titus 3:4-7)

2. Why is it important that believers are given the Holy Spirit?

- The Holy Spirit is our <u>guarantee</u>. (Acts 15:8-9; Ephesians 1:13-14; 2 Corinthians 1:22)
- The Holy Spirit is our helper. (John 14:16-17)

3. Why do works matter after salvation?

 Our <u>obedience</u> to Christ recognizes and proclaims His Lordship. (Acts 15:20-21; Ephesians 2:10; Romans 8:29; John 14:26)

Communion What is it?

Communion is a visible representation of the Good News of the death of Christ for our sins. It reminds us of Christ's death and the glorious hope of His return. The bread and wine symbolize Christ's Body and blood.

Who can participate?

All who trust in Jesus Christ and Him alone for forgiveness of their sins are welcome to participate, regardless of church affiliation.

Romans 3:23 Admit you are a sinner.

Romans 6:23 Recognize the penalty for your sin is death.

Romans 5:8 Jesus Christ died for you.

• Romans 10:9-10 To be forgiven for your sins, you must

believe and confess that Jesus was God who

died for your sins and He is Lord.

John 14:6 Salvation comes through Jesus Christ and

Him alone.
