30As He spoke these words, many believed in Him.

John 8:30 (NKJV)

31Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, “If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. John 8:31 (NKJV)

32And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.” John 8:32 (NKJV)

33They answered Him, “We are Abraham’s descendants, and have never been in bondage to anyone. How can You say, ‘You will be made free’?”

John 8:33 (NKJV)

34Jesus answered them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin. John 8:34 (NKJV)

35And a slave does not abide in the house forever, but a son abides forever. John 8:35 (NKJV)

36Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed. John 8:36 (NKJV)

12Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him. James 1:12 (NKJV)

13Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone.

James 1:13 (NKJV)

14But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. James 1:14 (NKJV)

15Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death. James 1:15 (NKJV)

Sin wants to turn you into the person who would not accept god even if you were face to face with him revealing himself.

37"I know that you are Abraham's descendants, but you seek to kill Me, because My word has no place in you. John 8:37 (NKJV)

38I speak what I have seen with My Father, and you do what you have seen with your father." John 8:38 (NKJV)

God creates sons & daughters who can see reality

39They answered and said to Him, “Abraham is our father.”

Jesus said to them, “If you were Abraham’s children, you would do the works of Abraham.

John 8:39 (NKJV)

40But now you seek to kill Me, a Man who has told you the truth which I heard from God. Abraham did not do this.

John 8:40 (NKJV)

41You do the deeds of your father.”

John 8:41 (NKJV)

God creates sons & daughters who work for things that last

41You do the deeds of your father.”

Then they said to Him, “We were not born of fornication; we have one Father—God.”

John 8:41 (NKJV)

42Jesus said to them, “If God were your Father, you would love Me, for I proceeded forth and came from God; nor have I come of Myself, but He sent Me.

John 8:42 (NKJV)

God creates sons & daughters who truly love

43Why do you not understand My speech? Because you are not able to listen to My word.

John 8:43 (NKJV)

44You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it.

John 8:44 (NKJV)

45But because I tell the truth, you do not believe Me.

John 8:45 (NKJV)

46Which of you convicts Me of sin? And if I tell the truth, why do you not believe Me?

John 8:46 (NKJV)

47He who is of God hears God's words; therefore you do not hear, because you are not of God."
