



justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through <u>faith</u> in his

blood...that he might be just, and the justifier of

him which believeth in Jesus.

Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by

faith without the deeds of the law.

Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? Knowing that a man is **not** justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe. #### THE BOOK OF HEBREWS

- Chapter 2:3 How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation...
  - 17 ...he might be a merciful & faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make **reconciliation** for the sins of the people.
- Chapter 3:1 ...holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus;
- **Chapter 4:14** We have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast **our profession**.
- Chapter 5:9 And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;
- Chapter 6:9 But, beloved, we are persuaded better things of you, and things that accompany salvation, though we thus speak.
- **Chapter 7:**22 By so much was Jesus made a surety of a **better testament**.
  - 25 Wherefore he is **able also to save them** to the uttermost that come unto God by him...
- Chapter 8:6 He is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises.
- Chapter 9:14-15 How much more shall the **blood of Christ**, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God...
- Chapter 10:10 By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.
  - 23-25 Let us hold fast the **profession of our faith** without wavering.
- **Chapter 11:**1 Now **faith** is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.
- Chapter 12:1-2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith.
  - 5-10 And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children...
- **Chapter 13:**5 For he hath said, **I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee**.

## Heb. 6:1 Therefore

Heb. 6:6 ≠ it is impossible for a backslidden Christian to get right with God.

Heb. 6:6 ≠ that it is impossible for a backslidden believer to repent and find forgiveness.

1 Jn. 1:9 "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

Jn. 6:37 "Him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out."

Ez. 33:14-16 "I say unto the wicked, <u>if he turn from his sin</u>, and do that which is lawful and right, <u>he shall surely live</u>, he shall not die. None of his sins that he hath committed shall be mentioned unto him."

Heb. 6:6 ≠ believers can't RETURN to Christ.

Heb. 6:6 = believers can't CONVERT to CHRIST again because they were already converted.

Heb. 6:6 ≠ a believer can LOSE their SALVATION.

Heb. 6:6 = a believer CAN'T LOSE their Salvation because it's Impossible to get Saved AGAIN.

It is IMPOSSIBLE to become a NEW Creature when you're already a New Creature...

It is IMPOSSIBLE to become a NEW Child of God when you're already a Child of God...

4 For it is <u>impossible</u> for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly GIFT, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost, 5 And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come, 6 If they (BELIEVERS) shall fall away (BACKSLIDE) it is impossible to renew them again unto <u>repentance</u>; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God <u>afresh</u> (AGAIN), and put him to an open shame.

Why is it impossible for a believer to "renew them again unto repentance?"

- (a) Because we can't lose what we were given (free gift vs. 4)
- (b) Because Christ didn't die "Once for All" to be needed "More than Once."

Heb. 6:6 ≠ a backslidden believer puts Jesus Christ to an "OPEN SHAME"

Heb. 6:6 ≠ a backslidden believer isn't allowed to repent.

Heb. 6:6 ≠ a backslidden believer is unworthy of salvation.

4 For it is <u>impossible</u> for those who were <u>once enlightened</u>, and have <u>tasted of the heavenly GIFT</u>, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost, 5 And have <u>tasted the good word of God</u>, and <u>the powers of the world to come</u>, 6 If <u>they</u> (BELIEVERS) shall *fall away* (BACKSLIDE) it is <u>impossible</u> to renew them again unto <u>repentance</u>; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God <u>afresh</u> (AGAIN), and put him to an open shame.

Needing to get Re-NEW-ed by Repentance or RE-SAVED puts Jesus Christ to an **OPEN SHAME** because it declares His Initial Sacrifice INSUFFICENT.

Heb. 6:6 = it's a "ONE-TIME for ALL TIMES" Salvation. Therefore, Grow Beyond Salvation!

Heb. 10:10-14 "...we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ <u>once for all</u>.

And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins: But this man, after he had offered <u>one sacrifice for sins for ever</u>, sat down on the right hand of God...

For by one offering he hath <u>perfected for ever</u> them that are sanctified.
