- 28 Verily I say unto you, All sins shall be forgiven unto the sons of men, and blasphemies wherewith soever they shall blaspheme: 29 But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation:
- 30 Because they said, He hath an unclean spirit.
- Parallel Passage that deals with the Commissioning of the Twelve Disciples.
- The context is not dealing with BELIEVERS POST-SALVATION; The context is dealing with UNBELIEVERS PRE-SALVATION.
- He who REJECTS or DENIES Christ as the SON of GOD "hath never forgiveness."
   He who SAYS that Christ doesn't have the SPIRIT of God "hath never forgiveness."

Mk. 3:29 "But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation."

OR

Jn. 10:28 "And I give unto them eternal life;

and they shall never perish."
