



The Epistle of JAMES: Confronting HYPOCRISY

(not Explaining Salvation)

1:22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only...

26 If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, this man's religion is vain.

27 Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this...

3:10 Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be.

4:4 Know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God?

2:1 My brethren, have not the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory, with respect of persons.

James 2:21 Was not Abraham our father justified by works?

24 Ye see then how that by works a man is justified...

Rom. 4:1 What shall we say then that <u>Abraham our father</u>...

2 For <u>if</u> Abraham were <u>justified by works</u>, <u>he hath whereof to glory</u>;

but not before God.

5 But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness.

Rom. 3:20 By the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight:

Rom. 3:24 Being justified freely by his grace...

Rom. 3:28 We conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.

Gal. 2:16 Knowing that a man is <u>not justified by the works of the law</u>, <u>but by the faith</u> <u>of Jesus Christ</u>, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be <u>justified by the faith of Christ</u>, <u>and not by the works of the law</u>: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

A man CANNOT be eternally and spiritually JUSTIFIED by WORKS.

A man CANNOT be eternally and spiritually JUSTIFIED by WORKS in GOD'S EYES.

James 2 is talking about being JUSTIFIED by WORKS in MAN's EYES!

Our FAITH is JUSTIFIED by WORKS in the Court of Public Opinion.

Our FAITH without Works is DEAD to our COMMUNITY.

James 2 has nothing to do with defining or explaining Biblical Salvation. James 2 has nothing to do with defining or explaining Eternal Security. James 2 has everything to do with addressing Christian Hypocrisy.
