

Rom. 10:1 "My heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel..."

- 12 "For there is no difference between the Jew & the Greek..."
- 18 "But I say, Have they not heard?"
- 19 "But I say, Did not Israel know?"
- 21 "But to Israel he saith..."

Rom. 11:1 "I say then, Hath God cast away his people?"

7 "What then? Israel hath not..."

The context is clearly primarily about the NATION of ISRAEL and how it has affected the GENTILE PEOPLE.



Rom. 11:22 "Behold therefore the goodness and severity of God: on **them** which fell, severity; but toward **thee**, goodness, if **thou** continue in his goodness: otherwise **thou** also shalt be cut off."

"Them" = the NATION of ISRAEL;
not Jewish people within the Jewish Nation

"Thee" = the GENTILE PEOPLE;
not Gentile people within the Gentile Nations

"THOU" = the GENTILE PEOPLE;
not Gentile people within the Gentile Nations

The context has nothing to do with individuals — it is a broad, general, national application.
