When we accept Christ's Sacrificial Death for our sin, we become **INVISIBLE to the LAW**, DEAD to the LAW.

Rom. 7:6 "NOW we are delivered from the law..."

Rom. 8:1 "There is therefore NOW <u>no condemnation</u> to them which are <u>in Christ Jesus</u>, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit."

A Believer no longer walks AFTER the FLESH because he is no longer IN THE FLESH.

A believer now walks AFTER the SPIRIT because he is now IN CHRIST JESUS.
