Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight...

Even *the righteousness of God* which is by <u>faith</u> of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that

believe: for there is no difference: Being **justified freely** by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through **faith** in his **blood**...that he might be just, and the **justifier of**

him which **believeth** in Jesus.

Therefore we conclude that a man is **justified by**

faith without the deeds of the law.

Knowing that a man is **not** *justified* by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have **believed** in Jesus Christ, that we might be *justified* by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

THE BOOK OF HEBREWS

- Chapter 1:2-3 ...he had by himself **purged our sins**, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;
- Chapter 2:3 How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation...
 - 17 ...he might be a merciful & faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make **reconciliation** for the sins of the people.
- Chapter 3:1 ...holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus;
- **Chapter 4:14** We have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast **our profession**.
- Chapter 5:9 And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;
- Chapter 6:9 But, beloved, we are persuaded better things of you, and things that accompany salvation, though we thus speak.
- **Chapter 7:**22 By so much was Jesus made a surety of a **better testament**.
 - 25 Wherefore he is **able also to save them** to the uttermost that come unto God by him...
- Chapter 8:6 He is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises.
- Chapter 9:14-15 How much more shall the **blood of Christ**, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God...
- Chapter 10:10 By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.
 - 23-25 Let us hold fast the **profession of our faith** without wavering.
- **Chapter 11:**1 Now **faith** is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.
- Chapter 12:1-2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith.
 - 5-10 And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children...
- **Chapter 13:**5 For he hath said, **I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee**.

- Heb. 10:1 ...can **never** with **those sacrifices** which they offered **year by year** continually make the comers thereunto **perfect**.
- 4 For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.
- 10 ...we are **sanctified** through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ **once for all**.
- 11 And every priest <u>standeth daily</u> ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins:
- 12 But this man, after he had <u>offered one sacrifice for sins for ever</u>, <u>sat down</u> on the right hand of God;
- 14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.
- 18 Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin.

Heb. 10:10 ...we are Sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

- 12 But this man, after he had <u>offered one sacrifice for sins for ever</u>, <u>sat down</u> on the right hand of God;
- 14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.
- 18 Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin.
- O.T. Judaism's "Salvation" hinged on one's Religious Performance (their sacrifices); N.T. Christianity's "Salvation" hinges on Christ's Performance (His Sacrifice).
- Hebrews 10 teaches Eternal Security because Salvation hinges on Christ's Performance and not on our performance.
- To reject the doctrine of Eternal Security,
 one must believe that their Salvation hinges on their Religious Performance.

- 10 ...we are **Sanctified** through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ <u>Once for all</u>.
- 12 But this man, after he had <u>offered one sacrifice for sins for ever</u>, sat down on the right hand of God;
- 14 For by <u>one offering</u> he hath <u>perfected **for ever**</u> them that are sanctified.
- 18 Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for Sin.

Heb. 10:18 Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin.

26 For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth,

there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,

27 But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries...

- There is no more sacrifice for sins because Christ's ONE Sacrifice was Sufficient to Forgive.
- There is no more sacrifice for future sins because they have ALREADY been forgiven.
- Hebrews 10:26 ≠ one can lose their salvation when sinning willingly.
 Hebrews 10:26 = when we sin willingly, Christ's ONE sacrifice already covers that sin.
- Hebrews 10:27-31 was added to address the temptation early Jewish believers would have to think that they could do whatever they wanted if they couldn't lose their salvation.
- Hebrews 10:26-31 doesn't teach a loss of eternal life; only a possible loss of earthly life.
