## SAVED, SAVED, SAVED

**Jn. 3:17** “For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.”

**Jn. 10:9** “I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved...”

**Acts 4:12** “Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.”

**Rom. 10:9** “That if thou shalt confess w/ thy mouth the Lord Jesus & shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.”

**Rom. 10:13** “For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.”

**Eph. 2:8** “For by grace are ye saved through faith...”

## SAVED, SAVED, SAVED

**#1 - Gen. 47:25** “And they said, **Thou hast saved our lives...**”

**#2 - Ex. 1:17** “But the midwives feared God, and did not as the king of Egypt commanded them, but **saved the men children alive.**”

**#3 - Ex. 14:30** “Thus the LORD saved Israel that day out of the hand of the Egyptians; and Israel saw the Egyptians dead upon the sea shore.”

**#4 - Num. 10:9** “And if ye go to war in your land against the enemy that oppresseth you, then ye shall blow an alarm with the trumpets; and ye shall be remembered before the LORD your God, and **ye shall be saved from your enemies.**”

**#5 - Num. 22:33** “And the ass saw me, and turned from me these three times: unless she had turned from me, surely now also I had slain thee, and **saved her alive.**”

**#6 - Num. 31:15** “And Moses said unto them, **Have ye saved all the women alive?**”

## SAVED, SAVED, SAVED

**Josh. 6:25** “And Joshua saved Rahab the harlot alive, and her father's household...”

**1 Sam. 23:5** “So David saved the *inhabitants* of Keilah.”

**1 Sam. 27:11** “And David saved neither man nor woman alive...”

**2 Sam. 19:5** “...which this day **have saved thy life**, and the lives of thy sons and of thy daughters, and the lives of thy wives, and the lives of thy concubines;”

**2 Sam. 22:4** “I will call on the LORD...so **shall I be saved from mine enemies**.”

**2 Kings 14:27** “And the LORD saved them by the **hand of Jeroboam** the son of Joash.”

**2 Chron. 32:22** “Thus the LORD saved Hezekiah and the **inhabitants of Jerusalem from the hand of Sennacherib** the king of Assyria...”

**Ps. 34:6** “This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him & saved him out of all his troubles.”

**Ps. 106:10** “And he saved them from the hand of him that hated them...”

**Ps. 107:13** “Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble,  
and he saved them out of their distresses.”

**Mt. 27:42** “He saved others; himself he cannot save. If he be the King of Israel,  
let him now come down from the cross, and we will believe him.”

**Acts 27:20** “And when neither sun nor stars in many days appeared, and no small tempest lay  
on us, all hope that we should be saved was then taken away.”

**Acts 27:31** “Except these abide in the ship, ye cannot be saved.”

## CONTEXT, CONTEXT, CONTEXT

Mt. 10:16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves.

17 But **beware of men**: for **they** will deliver you up to the councils,  
and they will *scourge* you.

21 And the brother shall deliver up the brother to **death**...

22 And ye shall be **hated of all men** for my name's sake.

23 But when they persecute you in this city, flee ye into another:

28 And fear not them which kill the body...

- **The context is Imminent Persecution and Dangerous Ministry;  
The instruction is one of Survival – to stay alive.**
- **The context is Loss of Life, not Loss of Eternal Life.**
- **The context is about SECURITY, not INSECURITY.**
- **“SAVED” in this passage is not a reference to being “saved from sin.”**

Mt. 24:3 what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world?

6 And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars...but **the end** is not yet.

9 Then shall they deliver you up to be **afflicted**, and shall **kill** you:

10 ...shall **betray** one another, and shall **hate** one another.

13 But he that shall endure unto **the end**, the same shall be saved.

16 Then let them which be in Judaea **flee** into the mountains:

22 And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved:

30 ...see the **Son of man coming** in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

Lk. 21:27-28 And then shall **they see the Son of man coming** in a cloud with power and great glory. And when these things begin to come to pass, **then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh**.

Mt. 24:3 what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world?

- **The context is Imminent Persecution and Dangerous Ministry; The instruction is one of Survival – to stay alive.**
- **The context is Loss of Life, not Loss of Eternal Life.**
- **“SAVED” in this passage is not a reference to being “*saved from sin.*”**
- **Whoever applies Matthew 24:13 to anything but PHYSICAL SALVATION is taking the phrase OUT OF CONTEXT.**

**SAVED, SAVED, SAVED**

**ANY** teaching that concludes a person can be **saved** or invited into heaven by **ANY** amount or level of good works **IN ANY AGE** is a **FALSE TEACHING** because **ANY** such teaching has contradicted the most important teaching in the Scripture that **ONLY Jesus Christ can take away sins.**

## SAVED, SAVED, SAVED

Rev. 13:8 “And all that dwell upon the earth SHALL worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.”

Rev. 17:8 “The beast that thou sawest was, and is not; and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth SHALL wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.”
