- 16 Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:

- Whoever applies Matthew 24:13 to anything but PHYSICAL SALVATION is taking the phrase OUT OF CONTEXT.

ANY teaching that concludes a person can be Saved or invited into heaven by ANY amount or level of good works IN ANY AGE is a FALSE TEACHING because ANY such teaching has contradicted the most important teaching in the Scripture that

ONLY Jesus Christ can take away sins.

Rev. 13:8 "And <u>all</u> that dwell upon the earth <u>SHALL</u> worship him,

whose names are **not** written in the book of life

of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world."

Rev. 17:8 "The beast that thou sawest was, and is not; and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth

SHALL wonder, whose names were not written in the

book of life from the foundation of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is."
