King James Version

Wine is a mocker, strong drink is
raging: and whosoever is deceived
thereby is not wise.

Common English Bible

Wine is a mocker; beer a carouser.
Those it leads astray won't
become wise.

Douay-Rheims

Wine is a luxurious thing, and
drunkenness riotous: whosoever
is delighted therewith, shall not
be wise.

God's Word Translation

Wine makes people mock, liquor makes them noisy, and everyone under their influence is unwise.

Good News Translation

Drinking too much makes you
loud and foolish.
It's stupid to get drunk.

New Century Version

Wine and beer make people loud and uncontrolled; it is not wise to get drunk on them.

New International Reader's Version

Wine and beer make people loud
and uncontrolled; it is not wise to
get drunk on them.

New Living Translation

Wine produces mockers; liquor leads to brawls. Whoever is led astray by drink cannot be wise.

The Message

Wine makes you mean, beer makes you quarrelsome - a staggering drunk is not much fun.
