While it's not likely that all of these questions will be asked during your small group meeting, we believe that your personal walk with Christ will be strengthened as you meditate upon the truths that God is teaching you through His Word.

1. This whole passage is about Christians rightly dealing with heart issues. What's at stake if I fail to biblically deal with these issues?
2. How have you been exposed BY the virus?
3. Pastor Joe expanded the ways we can steal. Explain the four ways listed.
4. Which one is the area you most struggle with? Why do you think that is? How can you biblically improve giving here?
5. What are your primary motivations for Corporate Worship and Small Group? Are you going to primarily receive or give? Why?
6. Describe what someone whom is a taker, and by contrast a giver, does in relationships?
7. In your relationships, are you a giver or taker? In what ways?
8. How does "rendering service as to the Lord" impact the way you work in business, at home, in ministry, in relationships, etc.?
9. What is the easiest way for you to steal at work? What needs to change so this does not happen?
10. How have you seen God's gracious generosity in your life? What changes do you need to make in order to more clearly reflect God's heart of generosity?
