While it's not likely that all of these questions will be asked during your small group meeting, we believe that your personal walk with Christ will be strengthened as you meditate upon the truths that God is teaching you through His Word.

- 1. Jeff defined light as "to expose or bring an awareness to" What are we to expose to others?
- 2. How are you living as salt and light in your daily life? at work? at home? in ministry?
- 3. What does Christ's character look like? How do we shine that light?
- 4. If we are to reflect God's character, we need to know His character. How are you growing in your knowledge of God's character in order to better reflect Him?
- 5. Think back on your Christian walk, in what ways have you adopted God's character? How has that changed the way you treat those around you?
- 6. Paul in Romans 1:15 said he was "eager to preach the gospel." What stops us from being eager?
- 7. What Scriptures lay out the gospel in a simple way?
- 8. What is the gospel? Take a minute to have a few people explain it in a short and concise way.
- 9. What small step do you need to take this week in sharing the gospel?
- 10. How are you trying to point others (believers and unbelievers) to Christ on a daily basis?
