

## A Fruitful Spring: Faithfulness Galatians 5:22-23

This guide is intended to help you be better prepared to engage in making disciples in your small group. They are based off of the Sunday sermon listed in the top right corner. If you missed Sunday, make sure you take the time to listen to the sermon before your small group meeting. You can find the messages on our website.

Prayerfully considering these questions will help equip you to practice mutual ministry with your family at Vertical. While it's not likely that all of these questions will be asked during your small group meeting, we believe that your personal walk with Christ will be strengthened as you meditate upon the truths that God is teaching you through His Word.

- 1. Who is the most faithful person you know? What qualities made you choose them?
- 2. How has your understanding of Christlike faithfulness changed after hearing the message?
- 3. In what areas of your life are you known as a faithful person? (Recognized as a person of your word and trustworthy)
- 4. What are some examples of how God has been faithful to you? What has that taught you about God's character? How does that encourage you to pursue faithfulness?
- 5. How does remembering God's faithfulness increase your joy in God and your desire to obey Him?
- 6. How have you doubted God's faithfulness recently? What scripture combats this?
- 7. What kind of lies can be displaced by the truth of God 's faithfulness? Share ways to affirm God 's faithfulness.
- 8. Pastor Joe gave "five areas to be faithful" if you were to add a sixth, what would it be?
- 9. In which of the 5 areas do you need to pursue faithfulness? What is your next right step?
- 10. Leaders in our church pray for FAT (Faithful, Available, Teachable) people to disciple in Working for Christ. Why would faithfulness be important in serving the body of Christ?
- 11. Why is it so important that our yes be yes and our no be no?
