Prayerfully considering these questions will help equip you to practice mutual ministry with your family at Vertical. While it's not likely that all of these questions will be asked during your small group meeting, we believe that your personal walk with Christ will be strengthened as you meditate upon the truths that God is teaching you through His Word.

1. What do you believe about worship? How has that perspective changed?
2. Describe your ideal worship experience in church. What would happen and what wouldn't happen?
3. What's the primary goal of personal worship? Of corporate worship?
4. When it comes to worship, are you primarily a truth person or a spirit person? How do you know? What can you do to be more biblical in your worship? What are some steps we can personally take to minimize distractions when we worship?
5. Read Jesus' words in Matthew 15:8-9. What does this teach us about how we should approach worship? In what ways have you worshipped God in vain?
6. How often are you spending time in personal worship? What are some practical ways to grow in your worship of God?
7. How are you currently seeking to grow in and expand your knowledge of God in order to worship God more accurately and deeply?
8. When do you most often experience God's presence during worship?
9. Identify one activity you can remove from your daily routine this week and replace it with a time of worship.
10. Share a song you've "found yourself in."
