

Enjoying God: Witnessing 2 Cor 2:12-17

This guide is intended to help you be better prepared to engage in making disciples in your small group. They are based off of the Sunday sermon listed in the top right corner. Prayerfully considering these questions will help equip you to practice mutual ministry with your family at Vertical. While it's not likely that all of these questions will be asked during your small group meeting, we believe that your personal walk with Christ will be strengthened as you meditate upon the truths that God is teaching you through His Word.

- 1. How has your view of witnessing changed because of this sermon?
- 2. This is the 4th message in our Enjoying God series. Share with your group how you have been growing in your enjoyment of God in Bible Intake, Worship, and/or Giving.
- 3. How should the fact of God's sovereignty change the way you approach witnessing?
- 4. How does understanding that we witness from a position of victory change the way you evangelize?
- 5. What does it mean to be bold? In what ways does this definition empower your witness?
- 6. Are you a gospel peddler or a sincere witness (based on the definition given in the sermon)?
- 7. What connection does my witnessing have to the joy of God? What from our passage indicates this?
- 8. What if God answered your prayers and every person you prayed for and shared the good news of Jesus with last week was adopted into the family of God. How many new people would belong to the kingdom of God? What does your answer to the question reveal about your heart and practice?
