Prayerfully considering these questions will help equip you to practice mutual ministry with your family at Vertical. While it's not likely that all of these questions will be asked during your small group meeting, we believe that your personal walk with Christ will be strengthened as you meditate upon the truths that God is teaching you through His Word.

1. What cause do you have for celebration? How is it connected with the incarnation of Christ?
2. How are you on a rescue mission? How has the Lord provided for you on this mission?
3. Do you have a day on the calendar where Jesus saved you? Tell the group your testimony.
4. Christ came to bring light into the world. Are there areas in your life that you are trying to keep in darkness? What would repentance look like in this area?
5. How does Jesus bring us comfort this season?
6. Where does the Joy of Christ come from according to our passage in Isaiah?
7. Why was it necessary for Jesus to fulfill the OT prophecies?
8. How does the promise of Christ's second advent influence the way in which we celebrate the first advent?
9. How can you grow this next year in living on mission for Christ?
