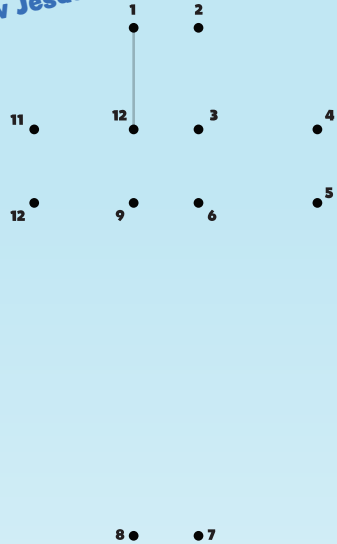


# A Drink of Living Water

Next to the well, draw Jesus telling the woman about the living water.

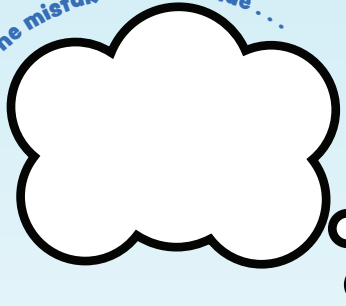
Where was Jesus sitting when he saw the Samaritan woman?

What kind of water does Jesus give?



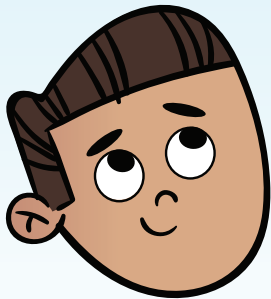
One mistake I have made...



One mistake someone else made...

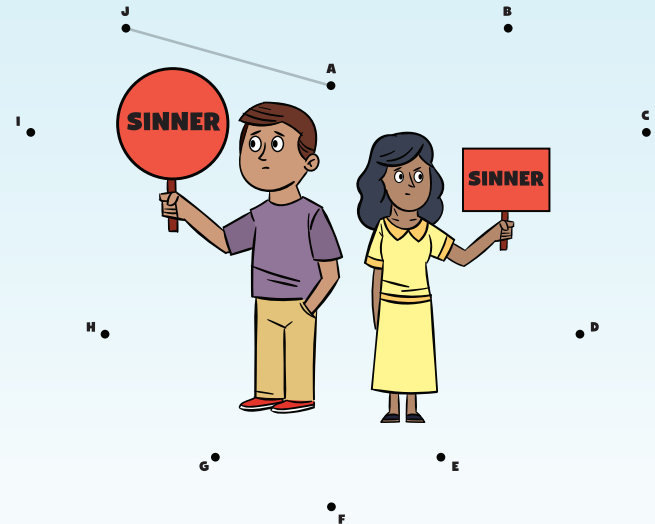


When someone makes a mistake, I can show mercy by...

## Jesus Offers Living Water

### John 4:5–42 (paraphrased)

One afternoon Jesus sent His disciples into a village for food while He sat alone beside a well. A Samaritan woman approached, and Jesus asked, “Would you please give Me a drink?”

Surprised, the woman said, “I know Jews don’t want anything to do with Samaritans. So why are You talking to me?”

Jesus responded, “If you knew who you were speaking to, you would ask Me for water.” This confused her because He didn’t even have a rope and bucket to collect water. Jesus explained, “I give living water. If you drink it, you will never thirst again.”

She gasped, “That sounds amazing! I want Your water.”

“Then go get your husband,” Jesus commanded, knowing she didn’t have a husband and why.
