



## **PRAISE PRAYER PLAN**

- Thank You for Your name, the strong tower I can run into for safety. Praise You for the power in Your name to heal, to save, and to deliver. Praise the Lord!
- I praise You, extol You, and lift Your name on high. Wonderful are Your ways and mighty are Your acts.
- In the midst of trials that come my way, I will praise You as Paul and Silas did at the midnight hour.
- Lord, you are high and lifted up. Let Your Shekinah glory fall as I praise Your name.

“Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands. Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing. Know ye that the LORD he is God: It is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations” (Psalm 100)
