

Matthew 3:1–11; Mark 1:1–5; 2:17; Acts 2:38:
An Important Message

Matthew 3:1–11 and Mark 1:1–5 (paraphrased)

John the Baptist had a special job—to prepare the hearts of the people for the coming Messiah, Jesus. John's ways were a little odd—his clothes were made of camel skin and he ate locusts dipped in honey. More important, people from all over Judea came to the banks of the Jordan River to hear him preach.

"Repent!" John would preach. "Repent of your sins and turn to God. Being a Jew does not bring you salvation. God's axe is poised and ready to chop down any tree who is not bearing good fruit. Repent and be baptized in water, because someone is coming who is greater than I am. He will baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire!"

As John preached, people who repented of their sins were immediately baptized by John in the river. John was showing the importance of repentance in God's plan of salvation.
