

An Outline of Luke 18:1-8

Thesis ¹Then He spoke a parable to them, that people always ought to pray and not lose heart, ² saying:

- A "There was in a certain city a judge
 - B who did not fear God
 - C nor regard man.
 - **D**³ Now there was a widow in that city;
 - E and she came to him,
 - **F** saying, 'Get justice for me from my adversary.'
- A' ⁴ And he would not for a while; but afterward he said within himself,
 - B' Although I do not fear God
 - C' nor regard man,
 - D' 5 yet because this widow troubles me
 - E' lest she keeps continually coming to me,
 - F' I will give her justice against her adversary.

Conclusion ⁶Then the Lord said, "Hear what the unjust judge said. ⁷And shall God not vindicate His own elect who cry out day and night to Him, though He bears long with them? ⁸I tell you that He will vindicate them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?"
