

## **Textual Outline of 1 Peter 4:1-6**

**A** Therefore, since Christ suffered for us in the <u>flesh</u>, arm yourselves also with the same mind, for he who has suffered in the <u>flesh</u> has ceased from sin, <sup>2</sup><u>that</u> he no longer should <u>live</u> the rest of *his* time in the flesh for the lusts of men, but for the <u>will of God</u>.

**B** <sup>3</sup> For we *have spent* enough of our past lifetime in doing the will of the Gentiles—when we walked in lewdness, lusts, drunkenness, revelries, drinking parties, and abominable idolatries. <sup>4</sup> In regard to these, they think it strange that you do not run with *them* in the same flood of dissipation, speaking evil of *you*. <sup>5</sup> They will give an account to Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead.

**A'** <sup>6</sup> For this reason the gospel was preached also to those who are dead, <u>that</u> they might be judged according to men in the <u>flesh</u>, but <u>live according to God</u> in the spirit.
