

## A Textual Outline of 2 Peter 2:4-10

**A** <sup>4</sup>For if God did not spare the angels who sinned, but cast *them* down to hell and delivered *them* into chains of darkness, to be <u>reserved</u> for <u>judgment</u>; <sup>5</sup> and did not spare the ancient world,

**B** but **saved** Noah, *one of* eight *people*, a preacher of righteousness,

**A'** bringing in the flood on the world of the ungodly; <sup>6</sup> and turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah into ashes, condemned *them* to <u>destruction</u>, making *them* an example to those who afterward would live ungodly;

**B'** <sup>7</sup> and <u>delivered</u> righteous Lot, *who was* oppressed by the filthy conduct of the wicked <sup>8</sup> (for that righteous man, dwelling among them, tormented *his* righteous soul from day to day by seeing and hearing *their* lawless deeds)—<sup>9</sup> *then* the Lord knows how to <u>deliver</u> the godly out of temptations

**A'** and to <u>reserve</u> the unjust under punishment for the day of <u>judgment</u>, <sup>10</sup> and especially those who walk according to the flesh in the lust of uncleanness and despise authority.

## Peter's Reminders in 2 Peter 2:4-10

- 1. God is not slack regarding sin and punishment.
- 2. God will judge (and punish) the supernatural world and their sin.
- 3. God will judge (and punish) the apathetic, moralists who thing they're fine without God.
- 4. God will judge (and punish) the rebellious, defiant, and spiteful world.
- 5. Oppression and torment caused by sinners are inevitable. Trust in the Savior!
- 6. God promises to deliver those who trust in Jesus Christ as Savior.
- 7. Keep focused on what "true righteousness" is. Don't make your Christianity a works-based religion.
