

An Outline of Luke 13:10-17

A ¹⁰Now He was teaching in one of the synagogues <u>on the Sabbath</u>. ¹¹And behold, there was a woman who had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bent over and could in no way raise *herself* up.

B¹² But when Jesus saw her, He called *her* to *Him* and said to her, "Woman, you are <u>loosed</u> from your infirmity."

C¹³And He laid *His* hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and <u>glorified</u> God.

A' ¹⁴ But the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because Jesus had healed <u>on the Sabbath</u>; and he said to the crowd, "There are six days on which men ought to work; therefore come and be healed on them, and not on the Sabbath day."

B' ¹⁵ The Lord then answered him and said, "Hypocrite! Does not each one of you on the Sabbath <u>loose</u> his ox or donkey from the stall, and lead *it* away to water it? ¹⁶ So ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has bound—think of it—for eighteen years, be <u>loosed</u> from this bond on the Sabbath?"

C' ¹⁷ And when He said these things, all His adversaries were put to shame; and all the multitude rejoiced for all the <u>glorious</u> things that were done by Him.

A / A': Sabbath B / B': Loosed! C / C': Giving Glory to God!
