A ¹⁴Therefore, beloved, looking forward to these things, be <u>diligent</u> to be found by Him in peace, without spot and blameless; ¹⁵ and consider *that* the longsuffering of our Lord *is* salvation

B —as also our beloved brother Paul, according to the wisdom given to him, has written to you, ¹⁶ as also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things, in which are some things hard to understand, which untaught and unstable *people* twist to their own destruction, as *they do* also the rest of the Scriptures.

A' ¹⁷ You **therefore, beloved**, since you know *this* beforehand, <u>beware</u> lest you also fall from your own steadfastness, being led away with the error of the wicked; ¹⁸ but <u>grow</u> in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him *be* the glory both now and forever. Amen.

Peter's Reminders in 2 Peter 3:14-18

- 1. Make every effort to live in peace.
- 2. Make every effort to remove those blemished lifestyles.
- 3. Jesus may not come back as quickly as you want Him to. Endure the pressures until He comes.
- 4. Watch out for people who are unteachable.
- 5. Don't get tossed around by the culture or the whims of the world.
- 6. Don't manipulate the Scriptures to get it to mean what you want it to say.
- 7. Remember the promises of the Word of God, lest we get discouraged.
- 8. Grow in your knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ. Grow in His grace.
- 9. Give God the glory!
