

## A Textual Outline of 2 Peter 1:16-21

**A** <sup>16</sup> For we did not follow <u>cunningly devised fables</u> when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were <u>eyewitnesses</u> of His majesty.

**B** <sup>17</sup> For He received from God the Father honor and glory when such a <u>voice</u> came to Him from the Excellent Glory:

C "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

**B'** <sup>18</sup> And we heard this <u>voice</u> which came from heaven when we were with Him on the holy mountain.

**A'** <sup>19</sup> And so we have the prophetic word <u>confirmed</u>, which you do well to heed as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts; <sup>20</sup> knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any <u>private interpretation</u>, <sup>21</sup> for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke *as they were* moved by the Holy Spirit.
