

Textual Outline of 1 Peter 4:12-19

Α	Beloved, do not think it strange concerning the <u>fiery trial</u> which is to try you, as though some strange
th	ng happened to you;

- **B** ¹³ but <u>rejoice</u> to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His <u>glory</u> is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy.
- A' 14 If you are reproached for the name of Christ,
 - **B'** <u>blessed</u> *are you,* for the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you. On their part He is blasphemed, but on your part He is <u>glorified</u>.
- **A'** ¹⁵ But let none of you <u>suffer</u> as a murderer, a thief, an evildoer, or as a busybody in other people's matters. ¹⁶ Yet if *anyone suffers* as a Christian,
 - **B'** let him not be ashamed, but let him **glorify** God in this matter.
- **A'** ¹⁷ For the time *has come* for <u>judgment</u> to begin at the house of God; and if *it begins* with us first, what will *be* the end of those who do not obey the gospel of God?
 - ${f B'}$ 18 Now "If the righteous one is scarcely <u>saved</u>, Where will the ungodly and the sinner appear?"
- **A'** ¹⁹ Therefore let those who <u>suffer</u> according to the will of God commit their souls *to Him* in doing good, as to a faithful Creator.

- **A / A'** = Fiery Trials, Suffering, Persecution, Reproached
- **B / B'** = Rejoicing, Glorifying God, and Ultimate Salvation
