

## An Outline of Luke 10:13-27

**A** <sup>13</sup> "Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works which were done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have <u>repented</u> long ago, sitting in sackcloth and ashes.

**B** <sup>14</sup> But it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the judgment than for you.

**A'** <sup>15</sup> And you, Capernaum, who are exalted to heaven, will be brought down to Hades. <sup>16</sup> He who hears you hears Me, he who rejects you <u>rejects</u> Me, and he who rejects Me rejects Him who sent Me."

A <sup>17</sup>Then the seventy returned with <u>joy</u>, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name."

- **B** <sup>18</sup> And He said to them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven.
  - **C** <sup>19</sup> Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions,
- B' and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

**A'** <sup>20</sup> Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, <u>but rather rejoice</u> because your names are written in heaven."

**A** <sup>21</sup> In that hour Jesus rejoiced in the Spirit and said, "I thank You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from *the* wise and prudent and revealed them to babes. Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight.

- **B** <sup>22</sup> All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, and who the Father is except the Son, and *the one* to whom the Son wills to reveal *Him.*"
- A' 23 Then He turned to His disciples and said privately, "Blessed are the eyes which see the things you see;
  - $B'^{24}$  for I tell you that many prophets and kings have desired to see what you see, and have not seen it, and to hear what you hear, and have not heard it."

A <sup>25</sup> And behold, a certain lawyer stood up and tested Him, saying, "Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?"

- **B** <sup>26</sup> He said to him, "What is written in the law? What is your reading of it?" <sup>27</sup> So he <u>answered</u> and said,
  - **C** "'You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind,' and 'your neighbor as yourself.'"
- **B** <sup>28</sup> And He said to him, "You have <u>answered</u> rightly;
