Has God's Word Failed? (9:6-13)

- No!
- God Unconditionally Elected Nation of Israel

Is God Unrighteous? (9:14-18)

- No!
- God Shows Immense Mercy and Compassion to Both Jews and Gentiles

Isn't All Sin Really God's Fault? (9:19-29)

- No!
- God is Longsuffering, Patient with Sin, and Makes His Glory Known Amidst the Sin

Is God Unfair? (9:30—10:17)

- No!
- Any-and-All Who Seek, Submit, Believe, and Obey Christ Jesus Shall Be Saved

What About Those Who Haven't Heard? (10:18-21)

- God Seeks Out All, and All Have Heard

Has God Cast Away Israel? (11:1-10)

- No!
- By God's Grace, There Will Always Be a Remnant of Saved Israel

Is There Hope for Israel? (11:11-32)

- Yes!
- Any Unsaved Jew (and Gentile) Will Be Saved Based on the Gospel and Faith
