Scriptures about the Resurrection

Job 19:25-27: “For I know that my Redeemer lives, and He shall stand at last on the earth. And after my skin is destroyed, this I know, that in my flesh I shall see God whom I shall see for myself. And my eyes shall behold, and not another. How my heart yearns within me!”

Psalms 16:10: “For You will not leave my soul in the grave, nor will You allow Your Holy One to see decay.”

Psalms 49:15: “But God will redeem My soul from the power of the grave. For He shall receive Me.”

Isaiah 26:19: “The dead shall live; together with My dead body they shall arise. Awake and sing, you who dwell in dust; for your dew *is like* the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead.”
