B having compassion for one another; [*sumpatheis*] **How One Feels**

C love as brothers, [*philadelphia*] **Selfless, Genuine Love**

B' *be* tenderhearted, [*eusplanknos*] **How One Feels**

A' *be* courteous; [*tapeinophrones*, humble-minded] **How One Thinks**

A ⁹ not returning evil for evil

B or reviling for reviling,

A' but on the contrary blessing for evil,

B' and [blessing for reviling],

C knowing that you were called to this, that you may inherit a blessing. ¹⁰ For “*He who would love life and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips from speaking deceit. ¹¹Let him turn away from evil and do good; Let him seek peace and pursue it. ¹²For the eyes of the LORD are on the righteous, and His ears are open to their prayers; But the face of the LORD is against those who do evil.*”
