

## An Outline of Luke 13:31-14:6

**A** <sup>31</sup>On that very day some Pharisees came, saying to Him, "Get out and depart from here, for Herod wants to <u>kill</u> <u>You</u>." <sup>32</sup> And He said to them, "Go, tell that fox, 'Behold, I cast out demons and perform cures today and tomorrow, and the third day I shall be <u>perfected</u>.'

- ${\bf B}^{33}$  Nevertheless I must journey today, tomorrow, and the *day* following; for it cannot be that a prophet should perish outside of Jerusalem.
- **B'** <sup>34</sup> "O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the one who kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, as a hen *gathers* her brood under *her* wings, but you were not willing!

A' <sup>35</sup> S	See! Your	r house is left to you desolate; and assuredly, I say to you, you shall not see Me until <u>tl</u>	he time co	<u>mes</u>
when	you say,	' <u>Blessed is He who comes</u> in the name of the Lord!'"		

**A** <sup>14:1</sup>Now it happened, as He went into the house of one of the rulers of the Pharisees to eat bread on the Sabbath, that they watched Him closely. <sup>2</sup> And behold, there was a certain man before Him who had <u>dropsy</u>.

- **B** <sup>3</sup> And Jesus, <u>answering</u>, spoke to the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, "Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath?"
  - **C** <sup>4</sup> But they kept <u>silent</u>.
- **A'** And He took *him* and <u>healed</u> him, and let him go.
  - **B'** <sup>5</sup>Then He <u>answered</u> them, saying, "Which of you, having a donkey or an ox that has fallen into a pit, will not immediately pull him out on the Sabbath day?"
    - C' <sup>6</sup> And they <u>could not answer</u> Him regarding these things.
