

An Outline of Luke 10:1-12

A ¹Now After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go.

B ²Then He said to them, "The harvest truly *is* great, but the laborers *are* few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.

 ${\bf A'}$ ³Go your way; behold, I send you out as lambs among wolves. ⁴Carry neither money bag, knapsack, nor sandals; and greet no one along the road.

A 5 But whatever house you enter, first say,

B 'Peace to this house.' ⁶ And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it;

C if not, it will return to you.

B' ⁷ And remain in the same house, eating and drinking such things as they give, for the laborer is worthy of his wages.

A' Do not go from house to house.

A ⁸ Whatever city you enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you.

 ${\bf B}^{\,9}$ And heal the sick there, and say to them, 'The $\underline{\text{kingdom of God}}$ has come near to you.'

 $\mathbf{A'}^{\ 10}\,\mathrm{But}$ whatever city you enter, and they do not receive you, go out into its streets and say,

 B'^{11} 'The very dust of your city which clings to us we wipe off against you. Nevertheless know this, that the <u>kingdom of God</u> has come near you.' ¹² But I say to you that it will be more tolerable in that Day for Sodom than for that city.
