

## The Text of Romans 8:18-30

**A** <sup>18</sup> For I consider that the <u>sufferings</u> of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the <u>glory</u> which shall be revealed in us.

**B** <sup>19</sup> For the earnest expectation of the creation <u>eagerly waits</u> for the revealing of the sons of God. <sup>20</sup> For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it in <u>hope</u>; <sup>21</sup> because the creation itself also will be <u>delivered</u> from the bondage of corruption into the glorious <u>liberty</u> of the children of God.

**C** <sup>22</sup> For we know that the whole creation <u>groans</u> and labors with birth pangs together until now. <sup>23</sup> Not only that, but we also who have the firstfruits of the <u>Spirit</u>, even we ourselves groan within ourselves,

**B'** <u>eagerly waiting</u> for the <u>adoption</u>, the <u>redemption</u> of our body. <sup>24</sup> For we were saved in this <u>hope</u>, but hope that is seen is not hope; for why does one still hope for what he sees? <sup>25</sup> But if we hope for what we do not see, we <u>eagerly wait</u> for it with perseverance.

**C'** <sup>26</sup> Likewise the <u>Spirit</u> also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the <u>Spirit</u> Himself makes intercession for us with <u>groanings</u> which cannot be uttered. <sup>27</sup> Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the <u>Spirit</u> is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

**A** <sup>28</sup> And we know that <u>all things</u> work together for <u>good</u> to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose. <sup>29</sup> For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. <sup>30</sup> Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified.
